About the Event

Potential candidates, aged between 16-25 years, are submitted for the awards by colleges and businesses for consideration in the five categories. These are judged by a panel made up of CDA professional members within the construction industry. The winners will be judged in advance and presented with their award, as well as gifts, on the evening. An overall winner, chosen from the five winning candidates, is also announced on the night.

The ceremony will highlight each winner's career or training so far and provide a stage from which the winners can inspire others. Following each award announcement, the winner will have the opportunity to give a short acceptance speech.

As part of the evening celebrations the event will raise money for a local young person's charity with a prize draw on the evening. The awards are hosted by a well know person, with previous years hosts being Charlie Dimmock, co-presenter of Ground Force; Dominic Littlewood, presenter of the TV series Cowboy Builders, and George Clarke, presenter of TV series Amazing Spaces and Restoration Man.
